The AOB advocates for:

- A European system to check the quality of apprenticeships and traineeships
- A set of minimum requirements for companies, and for company tutors
- Support to companies and tutors
- A curriculum for the training of company tutors
- Additional training and information for European countries, to help to increase the quality of WBL

The AOB considers good quality WBL extremely important for

- the European economy,
- A low level of youth unemployment
- maintaining good quality of VET
- Inclusion of ethnic minorities (or majorities in our cities) in our economy, availability of VET for all
