OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH STRATEGY FOR TEACHERS

Employee Assistance Service

Occupational Health Service

OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH STRATEGY

- Focus on healthy/decent workplaces
- Focus on prevention rather than cure
- Provides supports and resources for teachers and close family members

EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE SERVICE

- Provides teachers and family members with easy access to confidential counselling.
- Assistance with coping with effects of personal and work related issues.
- Free and confidential 24/365
- Telephone and face to face counselling.

OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE

- Provides employers with advice on health matters that are relevant to employees
- Can refer employees who are 4+ wweks absent or repeated short absences
- OHS may contact employee, assess fitness to teach, provide supports, agree return to work programme

INTEGRATED WORKPLACE HEALTH MANAGEMENT INITIATIVE

- Education employers and teacher unions in Ireland are collaborating on a proposal to survey employees in first and second level schools
- Initiative focuses on health needs of employees and health and safety risks
- Ultimate aim = health screening, health promotion and return to work protocols

ETUCE AND EFEE — ONLINE INTERACTIVE RISK ASSESSMENT TOOL

OiRA tool being developed through social dialogue.

ETUCE and EFEE with support of European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (EU OSHA)

Identification of potential risks which may result in harmful stress

Multiplicity of risks –job insecurity, work load, technological change, societal factors, personal factors etc.

ONLINE INTERACTIVE RISK ASSESSMENT TOOL

- Meeting held in Bilbao on June 18
- Meeting planned for Dublin October 22/23

SMALL STEPS PROGRAMME -DONEGAL ETB

- An employer initiative focussing on inclusion, participation, encouragement and choice
- Began as a project for the National Workplace Wellbeing Day in Ireland
- Aim is to be a positive and caring organisation which supports employees to reduce stress factors increase self esteem and increase job satisfaction
