- Education and ICT challenges

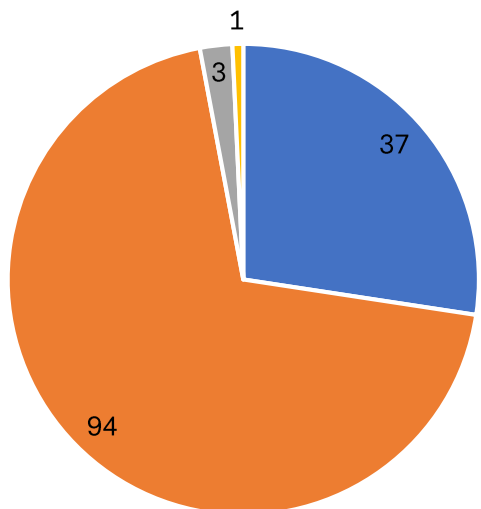
MODULE 3 -Whole school approach and rights-based approach.

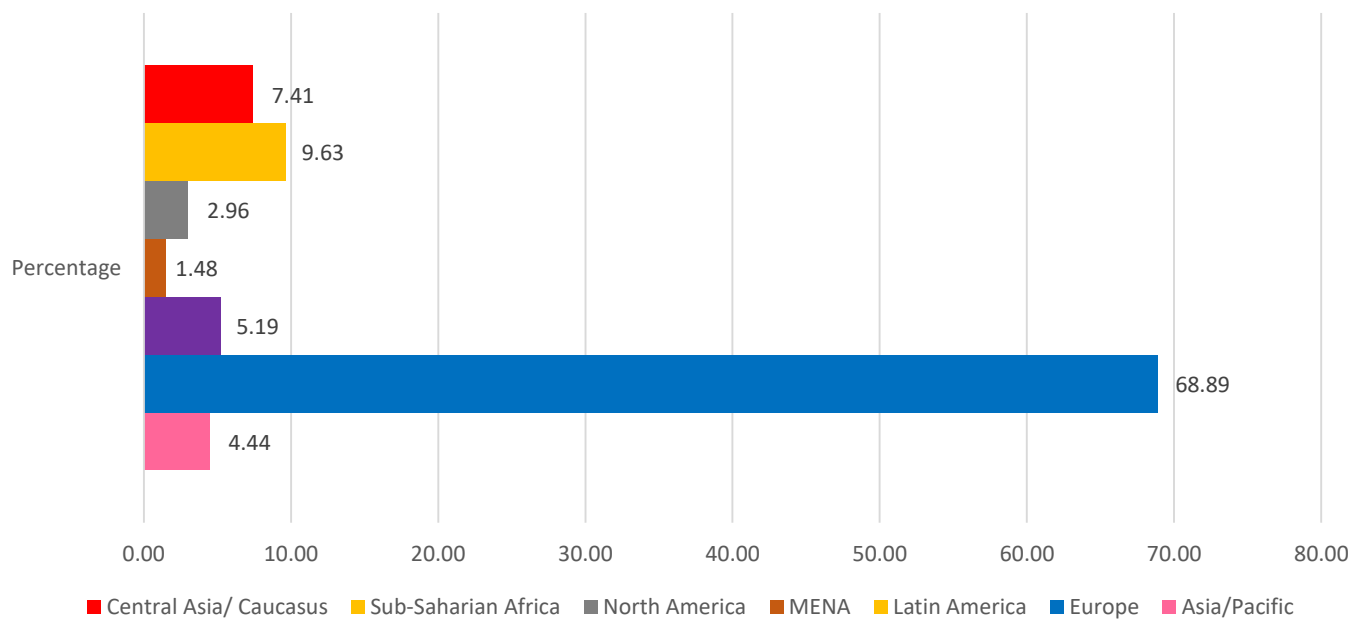
- 13 lecturers/experts

Gender

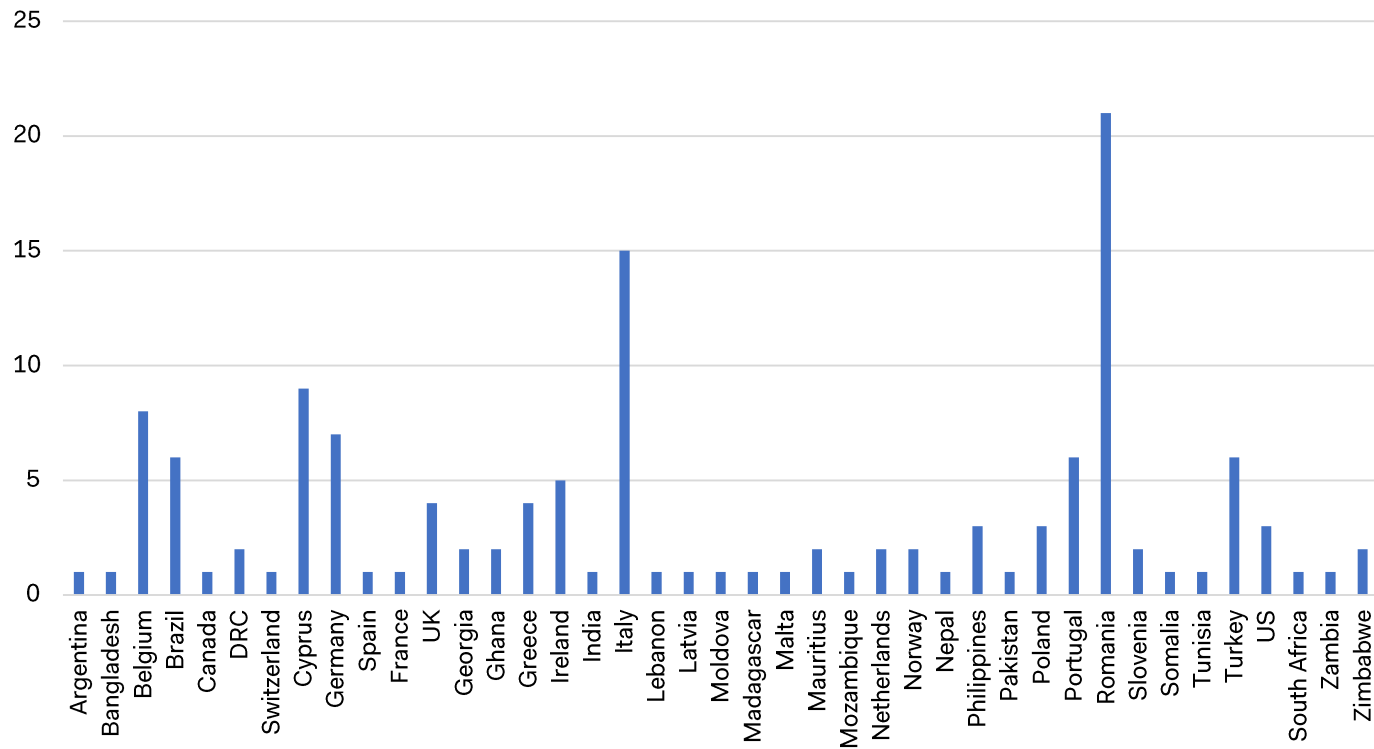

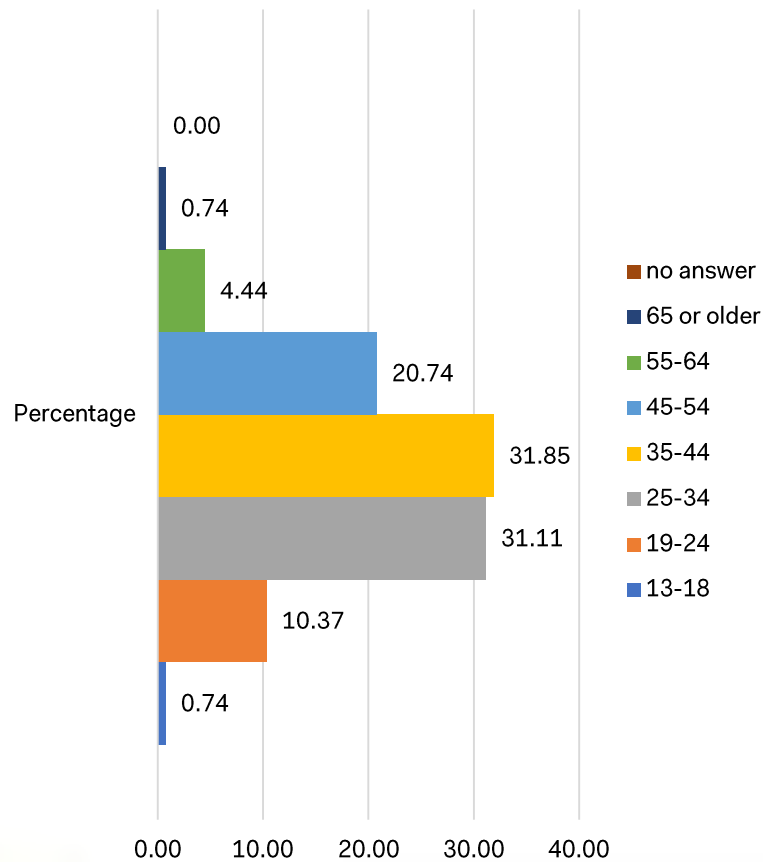
Participants by region



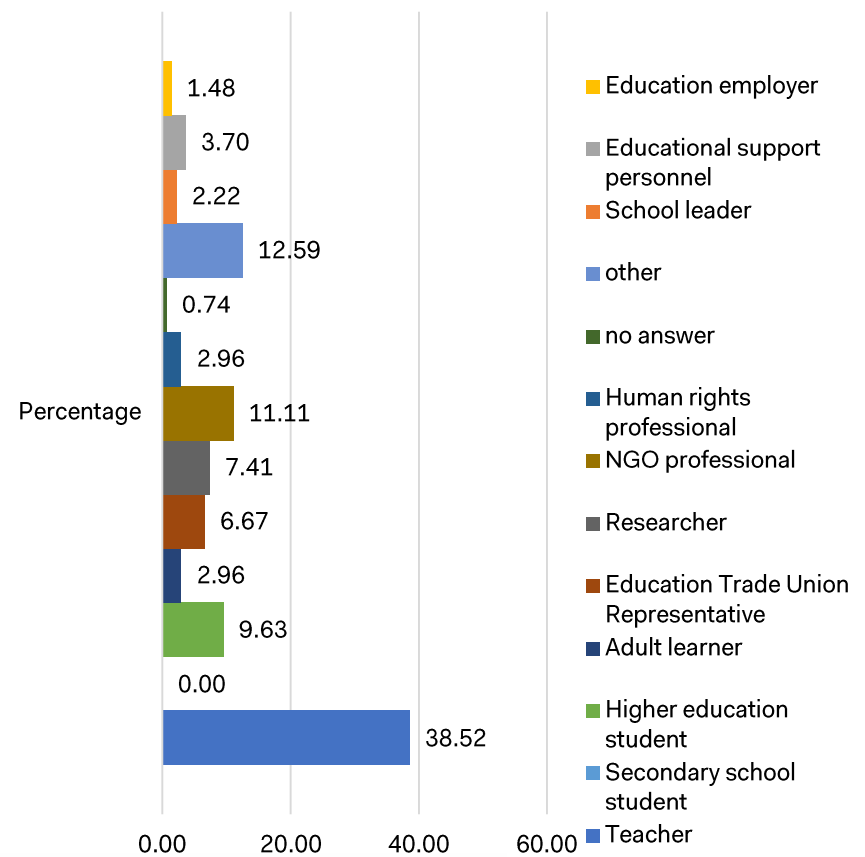
Certificates by Country

Approach

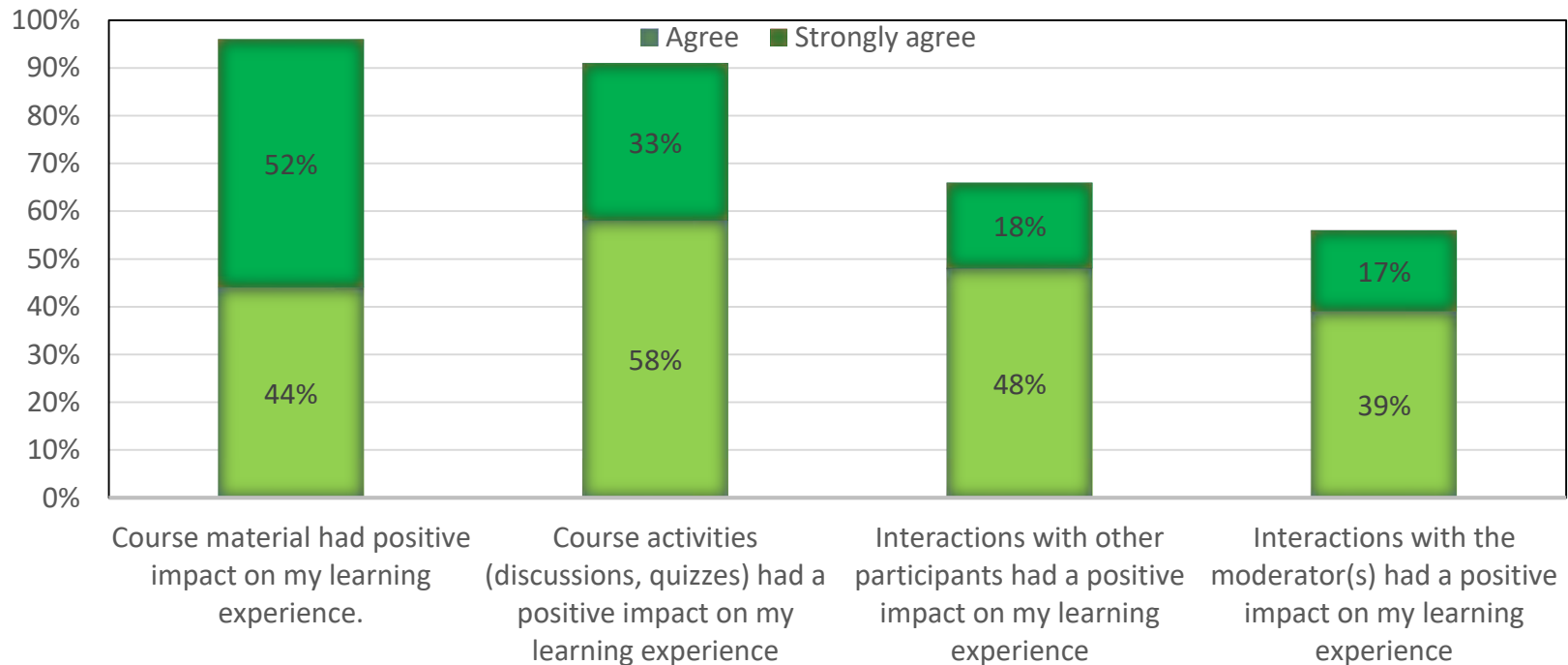
The course is based on a **participatory approach**

- 30 hours of active learning
- Readings, videos, **discussions, group-work/role-plays** and quizzes
- Case studies

On average 44 participants were involved in each discussion, for this reason we extended the course until the 30/6

We included among the reading materials, an important number of readings and good practices (**107**). The vast majority of these reflected the list in the “**Compendium of Good Practices and References**”
